

- be in good health as proved by medical examination record
- be able to communicate in English
- complete the Application Form
- be able to show admission letter (acceptance letter) from the intended universities in Indonesia (for Darmasiswa Short Course Program).
- show academic transcript
- show colour 5 photographs 4 X 6 cm size
- show passports that are still valid for at least 18 months

Requirements

- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Regular Program, prior to traveling to Indonesia, scholarship recipients must meet visa requirements for Social & Cultural Visit Visa (later on will be converted into a temporary resident visa valid for 1 year). Scholarship recipients are not allowed to apply for Tourist Visa.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Short Course Program, prior to traveling to Indonesia, scholarship recipients must meet visa requirements for Limited Stay Visa. This type of visa is granted by Directorate General of Immigration, Indonesia. It will be handled by the Ministry.
- Scholarship recipients must not be pregnant when traveling to Indonesia to begin study.
- Scholarship recipients must sign Statement Letter to be given by the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Ankara prior to traveling to Indonesia.
- Scholarship recipients must sign Agreement Letter to be given by the Ministry of National Education when arrived in Indonesia.
- Scholarship recipients must abide the condition of scholarship and the rules of Indonesian university/college/teacher training center.
- Scholarship recipients must abide the rules and regulation governing a temporary resident visa.
- Scholarship recipients must act in a way that will not bring dispute to Indonesian government or institutions.

Health Insurance & Flight Ticket

The Ministry does not provide health insurance or health coverage, and does not provide flight tickets to and from Indonesia. Students must pay their own health insurance and flight tickets.

Schedule

- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Regular Program, eligibility and requirement documents should have to be received at the latest in the second week of February 2008 by the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Ankara.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Short Course Program, eligibility and requirement documents should have to be received at the latest in the second week of December 2008 by the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Ankara.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Regular Program, selection of the documents for candidates will start in the first week of April 2008 by the Ministry.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Short Course Program, selection of the documents for candidates will start in the first week of January 2008 by the Ministry.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Regular Program, announcement of the scholarship recipients will be issued in the first week May 2008.
- For Darmasiswa Scholarship Short Course Program, announcement of the scholarship recipients will be issued in the second week of January 2008.
